Invitation

Affirmation of Faith - The Nicene Creed

I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible.

And I believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church. I acknowledge one baptism for the remission of sins; and I look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Confession of Sin

adapted from Psalm 19:12-13

Almighty God, Sovereign Lord, we come before you this morning, thanking you for the opportunity to return to public worship. To fellowship, gathered with one another in our worship of you. To stand, lifting our voices together, in unison. To sit, listening to your Word preached and proclaimed unto us. And now, to fall down before you, and confess our sins.

Lord, how can we know all of the sins lurking in our hearts? How can we know all of the deeply sinful faults in our own flesh that are hidden from us? We know that you know, and we confess them before you this day.

Cleanse us from all of our hidden faults. Keep us from all of our deliberate sins. Do not let them control us. Make us free of our guilt and innocent of our great sin. We repent of our wayward ways, and trust in Christ for the forgiveness of all our sins. It is in His great name we pray, Amen.
