

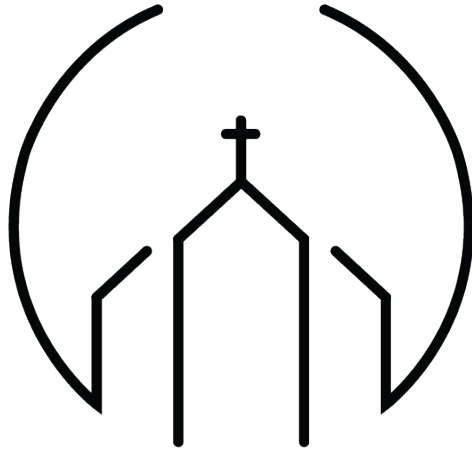

Invitation

Affirmation of Faith - The Apostles Creed

Almighty God, you are truly the King of kings and the Lord of lords. Everything in this world is yours, and there is nothing in all creation mightier than you. And yet, we often refuse to recognize that. We are eaten up by our fear, our pride, our lust, our envy, and our selfishness.
