



Get Wisdom! Mercy Discussion Questions (More questions are available in the back of the book and songs and other resources are available online):

1. Our verse for this week, Ephesians 4:32, states: we are to be kind and compassionate, forgiving other because God has forgiven us in Christ. Discuss the forgiveness in Christ and how it translates in showing mercy to others.
2. The definition for mercy says we are to show mercy to those who are weak, sinful, and needy. Who does this definition include? Is there anyone who does not deserve being shown mercy? Discuss.
3. There are certain people that we at times have hard showing kindness and compassion (See the book of Jonah). Who do you have trouble showing mercy? Why is this? Discuss.
4. Mercy at times means overlooking something that is done against you. It means letting yourself be subject to unfair treatment. Think of how Christ was treated unfairly and how you can respond like Christ did when He was on earth.
