



Get Wisdom! Contentment Discussion Questions (More questions are available in the back of the book and songs and other resources are available online):

1. The book says contentment is being “satisfied”. What does this word mean and what does it take for you to be satisfied? What causes you to not be satisfied?
2. Most of us are only satisfied when we get our own way. What does God call us to be satisfied with? What would this look like in your life?
3. The book says God is working everything together for my good and His glory. What do you think your good and his glory look like? Discuss this with your parents and how God’s view of your good and your view of your good can match up.
4. The greatest example of contentment was Jesus’ contentment. He was content to suffer for you. Consider this especially in His prayer to the Father in the Garden of Gethsemane (Matthew 26:36-56).
