

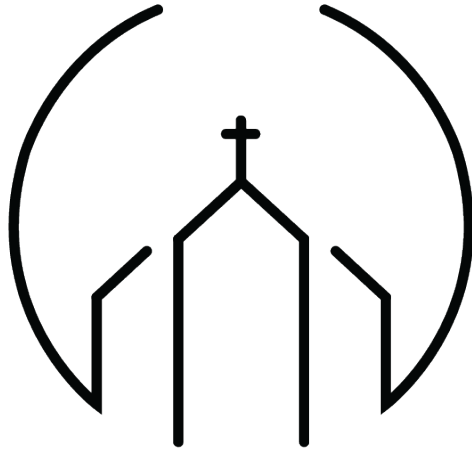

Affirmation of Faith – The Apostles Creed
