

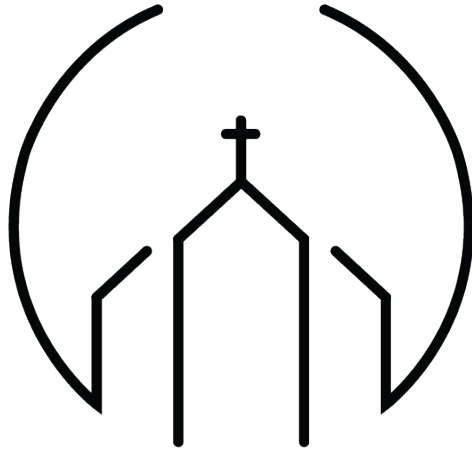

And thank you for granting us a perfect peace with you – our Heavenly Father – which has come to us only by the work of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, in whose name we pray. Amen!"
